

DAIRSIE COMMUNITY COUNCIL

Minute of meeting held in Memorial Hall at 7.30pm on **29th March 2007.**

Present- N Davis (Chair), L Woodcock, D May, S Williamson, S Hain, Cllr Douglas and 5 members of the public.

Minutes- These had been previously circulated and adopted as correct.

Matters Arising - The pedestrian crossing was more or less complete. Dairsie Bridge was being repaired. The road outside the school at Vantage had been resurfaced and the Chair was to contact Mr Murray to ascertain ownership of remainder of Vantage Road. Street lighting in Osnaburgh Ct and in the rest of the village had a new failsafe system. Lights tripped on if there was a fault rather leaving the area dark.

Councillor's Report- This was Councillor Douglas's last meeting. He had represented Dairsie for 7 years and had missed only 8 meetings. Mrs Davis thanked Councillor Douglas for his support and wished him a happy retirement .

Treasurer's Report- As instructed the Treasurer had determined the amounts to be distributed to local organisations. Pitcairn Trust £55, Hall £105, Newsletter £15, Youth Club £15. The Current Account stood at £12.14 and the Savings Account £302.14. The accounts would be updated at the beginning of April, audited and sent to Fife Council.
