

DAIRSIE COMMUNITY COUNCIL

Minute of meeting held in Memorial Hall on **Thursday 27th July 2007** at 7.30pm

Present- N Davis (Chair), E Woodcock, B Littlejohn, D May, S Williamson, Cllrs Guy, Kennedy, Poole and 4 members of the public.

Apologies – Colin Gilbert, Saul Hain.

Minutes- These had been previously circulated and adopted as correct.

Matters Arising-

Outline Planning Application for 2 houses at No 2 Main St. A letter of objection from the Community Council had been sent to Fife Council Development Services. At the time of the CC meeting the application had not been determined.

Pitcairn Trust Gala- This was to take place in the Park on 18th August to raise funds for the maintenance of the Park. There would be a dance in the Hall in the evening.

Snagging List

A reply had been received from the Transportation Department. Most items had been addressed and others had been delayed because of inclement weather. Further items had been identified by Mr Hain and this would be forwarded.

Cost of Speed Cameras and Signs etc- According to the police an electronic “Slow Down” sign would cost approx £1300 plus a connection from Scottish Power which could cost up to £500. Dairsie’s Slow Down sign was rotated every 8 weeks and had been relocated to the other end of the village after the 20 limit was introduced. It was decided that the Secretary would contact Transportation Services to enquire about more detailed information and if a local financial contribution could prove productive.

CC Visit to Police HQ- The CC had received an invitation to visit Police HQ in Glenrothes with suggested dates. Members wishing to attend N Davis, E Woodcock, B Littlejohn, D May. S Hain was included in his absence. The Sec would organise this. (* see end of minute)

Treasurer- The Annual Grant had been received from Fife Council. Current Account £329.68 Savings £304.46

A decision re distribution of funds would be made later in the year. The Treasurer was thanked.

Community Council Election-This would take place on Thursday 11th October if there were more than 8 nominations for Dairsie. Fife Council would be publicising CC Elections and availability of nomination papers at the end of August. The deadline for submission of Nomination Papers was September 13th.

Finalised Structure Plan- This was to be reviewed and if passed by Fife Council there would be a Consultation period. B Littlejohn was delegated to oversee.

New Fife Councillors-Cllrs Guy, Kennedy and Poole intimated they were working together and liaising on issues affecting their area.

AOCB- Points Raised-

There was concern about the condition of Main St and the condition of the drain outside No2.

There was a view that Scottish Water was dilatory with repairs and that repairs were only enacted if there was a major problem.

Obstruction of sightlines at 2 Osnaburgh Court and Edenbank turn off in Station Road. Transportation and the Police had been informed several times that there was increased traffic particularly farm vehicles in this area and it was only a matter of time before there would be a serious accident.
